

These are the common procedures to import cows:

1. There should be a trading agreement between Israel and the country of origin.
2. A request should be applied to the Ministry of Agriculture including the following documents:
 - a. Proforma invoice.
 - b. Certificate of origin.
 - c. Veterinary certificate.
3. If the ministry approves, it will send the application to another department (General Administration for Marketing) which studies market conditions and provides a second approval.
4. The approval is transferred to Veterinary Services' Department which send all documents to Beit Eil who in turn should give the final approval.
5. At port, the shipment is quarantined for two weeks to take the needed vaccinations which are on the importer's own expense.
6. There are no specifications or requirements for Milk percentage from the Palestinian side.
